He crawled in and within 20 minutes was sound asleep. Given the opportunity to do this, he took it upon himself to get into bed with her again that night, and that is when she peacefully died in his arms.*

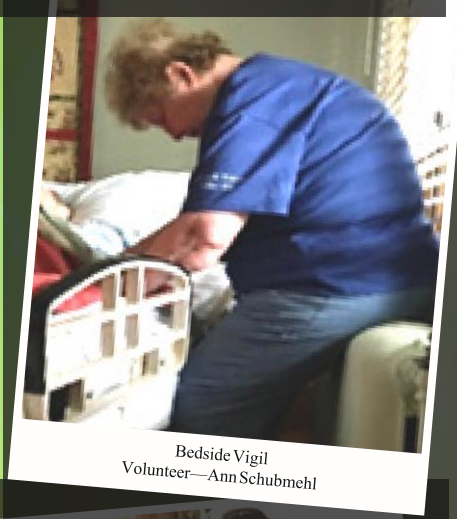
